

Transparency in Health Care Prices Act

The 2017 Colorado General Assembly passed legislation requiring greater transparency in provider prices enabling consumers to be better informed. Beginning Jan. 1, 2018 physicians will need to disclose to consumers the 15 most common services they provide and the associated charges when payment is made directly by the patients rather than by a third party.

In cooperation with the state of Colorado, *South Denver Cardiology Associates* is providing **health care prices for "health care services"**, complying with the Colorado Revised Statute: 25-49-103 – Transparency in Health Care Prices Act.
